## **FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION**

Join the dedicated volunteers who support children and families by helping organize and maintain FBB's food pantry! FBB staff utilize the food pantry to take emergency food boxes out to children and families enrolled in services. Families receive healthy foods and information on meal planning and budgeting. Volunteers shop weekly at Marion Polk Food Share, inventory items, check expiration dates, restock shelves and fridge/freezer, and keep the pantry organized and clean.

**Duration:** Minimum three-month commitment

**Time Commitment:** Minimum two hours per week, day and time dependent on assigned shopping time

- Friendly and outgoing with fellow volunteers and staff
- Complete a successful criminal history check, FBB Volunteer Application, and Oregon Food Handler's Card
