## **CLOTHING CLOSET VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION**

Join the dedicated volunteers who help organize our clothing closet, a special resource for all children and families enrolled in FBB's prevention programs. The FBB clothing closet is a boutique-style room filled with children's clothing, accessories, and supplies provided by in-kind donations. Families receive vouchers to 'shop' in the closet for their children once per month to help them save money on clothing for their growing children. Volunteers sort clothes, pair outfits, inventory items, and keep the closet organized and tidy for families to shop.
